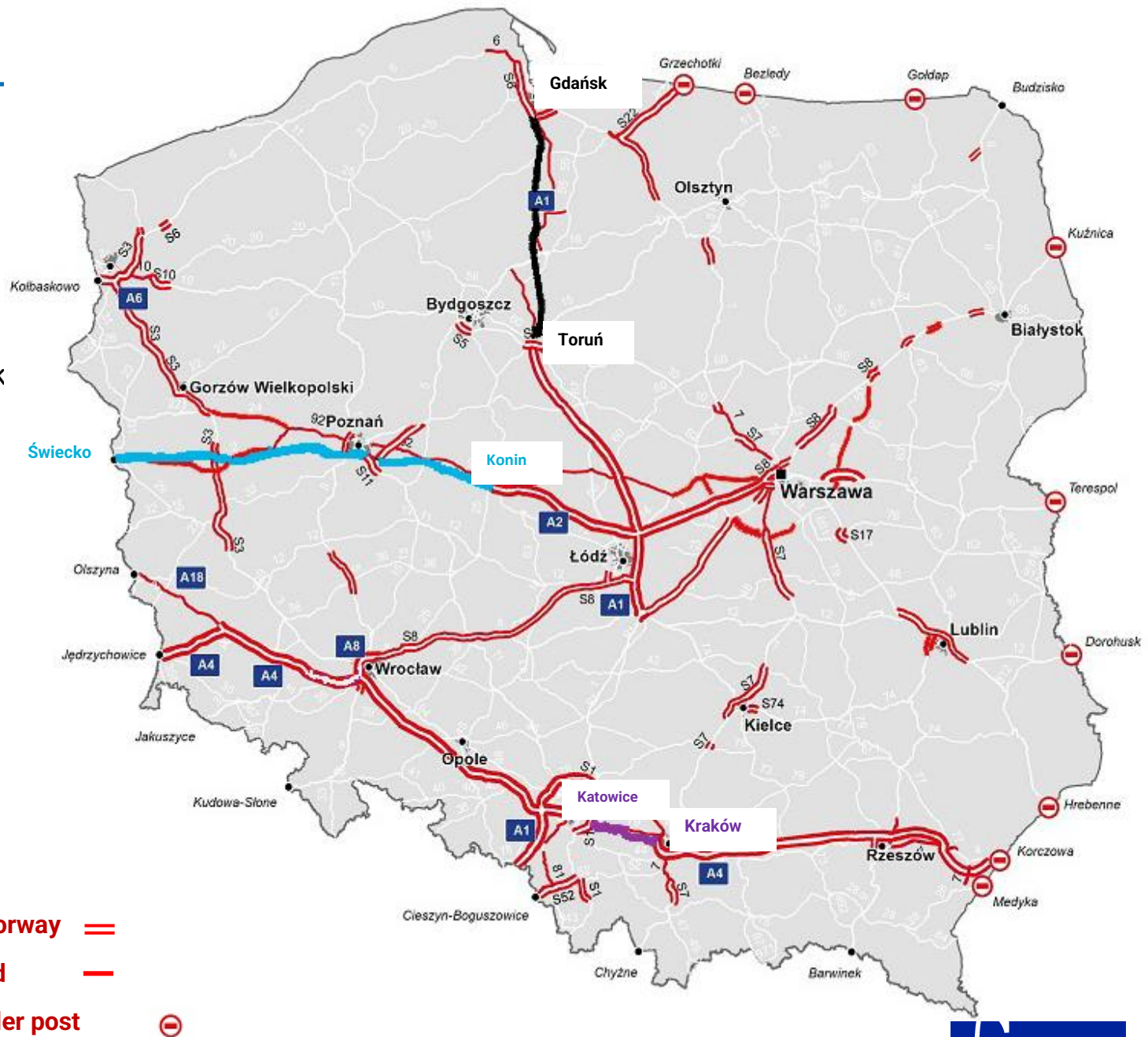


TAKE THE LEAD

The Polish network

Managed by the Polish transport ministry, the road network divided into several distinct motorways and national highways.

- The concessionary or public network (the eToll network **1600 km**)
 - The non-concessionary network, owned by private concessions (**468 km**)
- **A1 Toruń – Gdańsk**
 - **A2 Świecko – Konin**
 - **A4 Katowice – Kraków**

How to pay on this network

- **The A2 motorway:** Świecko (German border) – Kukuryki (Belarusian border) has a toll system independent of the eToll taxable network. Tolls are paid at toll terminals.

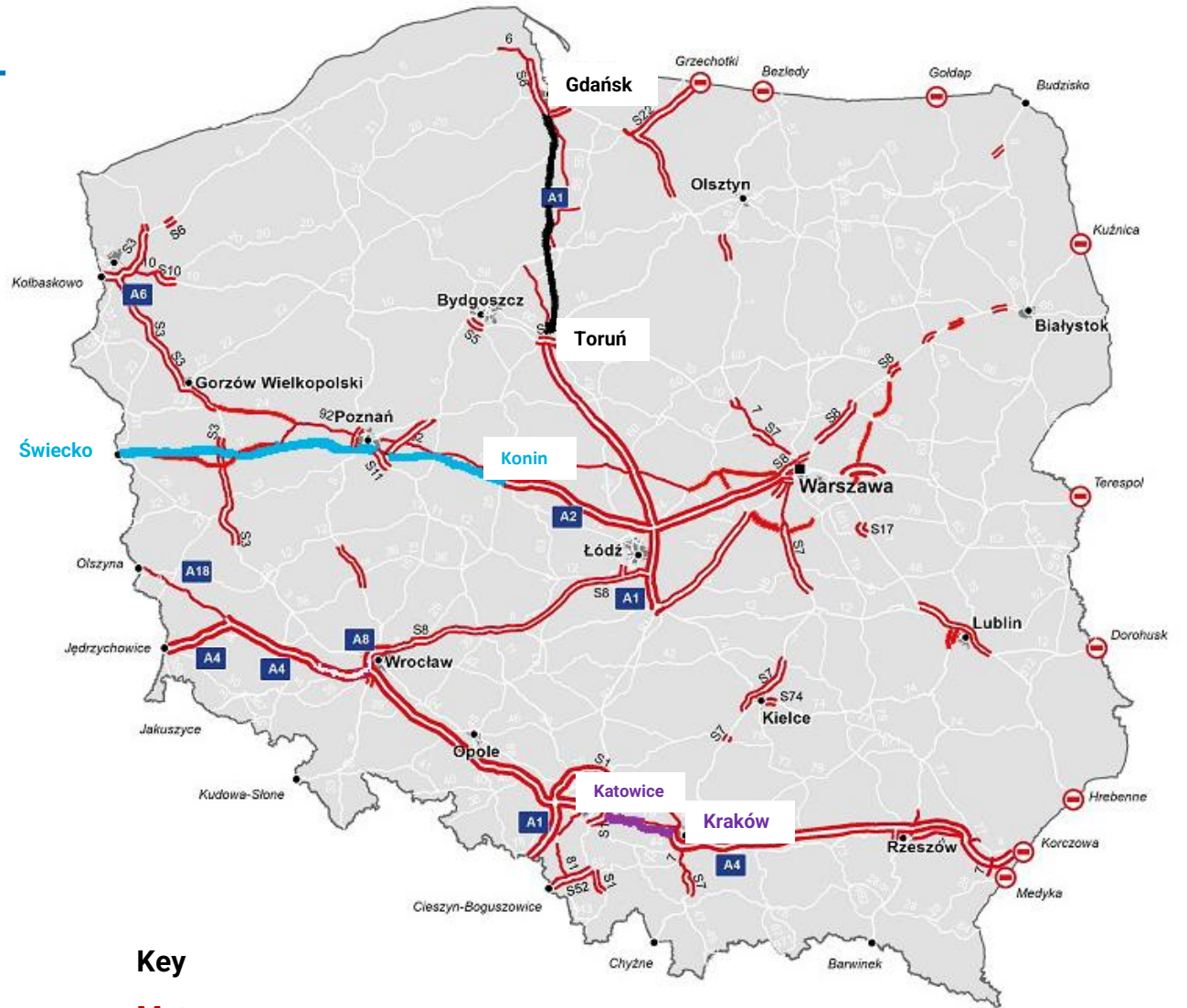

Vehicles subject to tolls and pricing grids

eToll network

- Freight transport:
vehicles with a GVWR > 3.5 tonnes
- Passenger transport:
vehicles with more than 9 seats

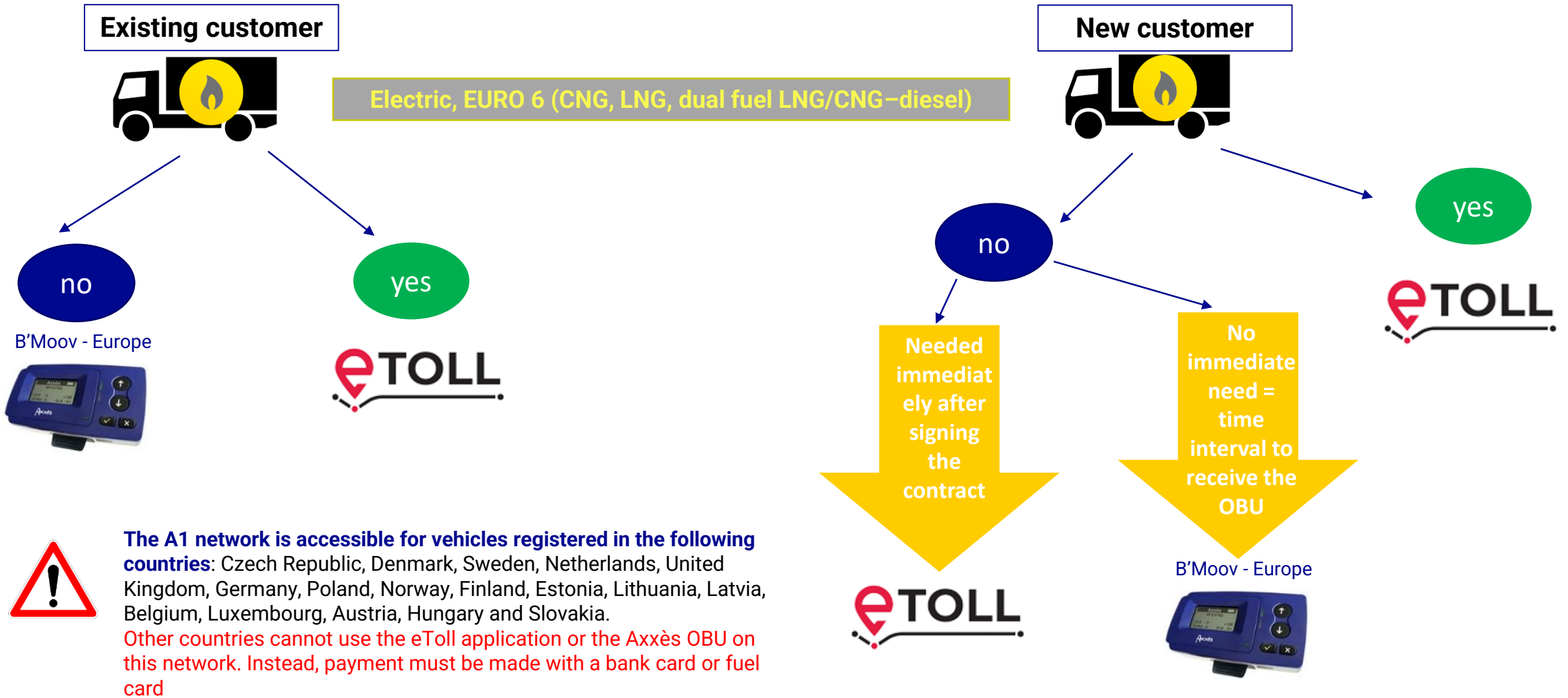

A1 and A4 network

- Freight and passenger transport:
Vehicles with at least 2 axles.

Vehicle category	Toll price in PLN (net) per km travelled
Vehicle with 3 axles	0.38
Vehicle with more than 3 axles	0.38

Invoicing



Deferred invoicing

- ⇒ Transactions are recorded from 01/10/2021 to 30/11/2021.
- ⇒ Invoices will arrive on 15/12/2021 (for transactions since 01/10/2021).

Invoice terms

All customers are invoiced a basic figure in zloty. The amount is then converted to euros using the average ECB exchange rate and the invoice must be paid in euros.

Special cases

Polish customers may be invoiced in zloty (PLN) and may pay in zloty (PLN).



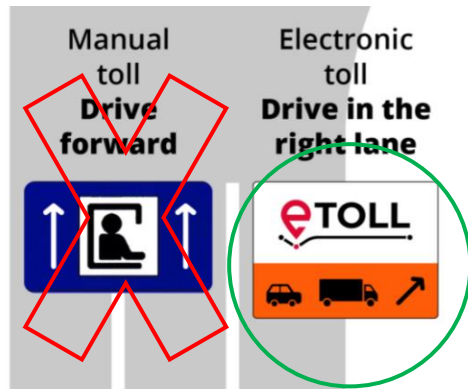
Using the right lane in Poland

In Poland, customers' tolls are collected either using the **Axxès B'Moov OBU** and the **eToll HGV app** on the public network or via **ANPR cameras** (for networks using video tolling) on private networks.

eToll network  **and public A4 (Wrocław–Sośnica)** **Public A1 and private A4 network: ANPR cameras**

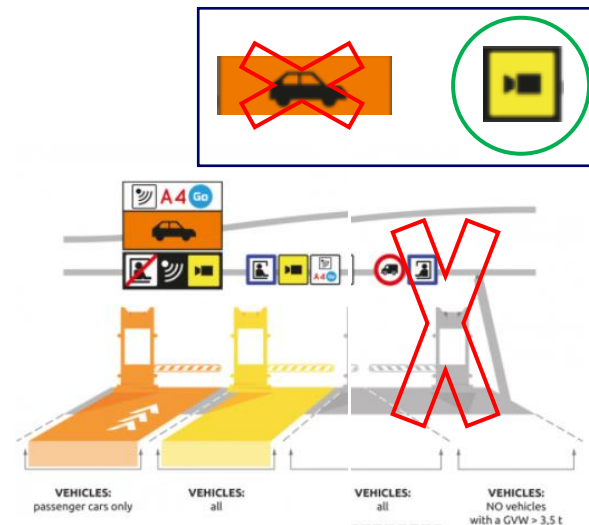
Most sections have no toll plazas.

On the sections of the A4 (Wrocław–Sośnica) that do have toll plazas, the customer must use the lane corresponding to the eToll system, marked as below:



Lane markings, eToll network toll plazas

Networks that use video tolling are equipped with toll plazas. At these plazas, customers must use the following lanes:



A4 network toll plaza (Katowice–Kraków)



A1 network: any lane

Back-up procedure



If the barrier does not open on the private A1 and A4 networks

When entering: use the intercom



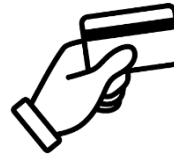
Or take a ticket



When leaving: head for this sign



And pay by bank card




eToll network – Public

If you arrive near the border and your B'Moov OBU displays **red LEDs**



1/ Stop the vehicle

2/ Register at the eToll site and download the app 

You will need a bank card or a fuel card and the vehicle's registration number.
